



## 2019-2020 Tuition Pricing Sheet

subject to change or become more definite as costumes catalogs come in.

\*\*\*Enrollment fee (covers classes from September through August) is \$25 per student and due at time of enrollment (not considered enrolled until proper paperwork and enrollment fee is paid).

\*\*\*Tuition: \$40 per month for a 1 hour/week class; additional classes for the same student are \$25 per month per class. Additional family members follow the same tuition scale but the 2<sup>nd</sup> child gets a 20% discount, 3+ get a 30% discount on that student. For example...Anna takes 3 classes ( $40 + 25 + 25 = 90$ ) and has a brother Bob who takes 2 classes ( $40 + 25 \times 20\% \text{ discount} = 52$ ) and a sister Sara who takes one class ( $40 \times 30\% \text{ discount} = 28$ ) so this family's monthly tuition would be \$170 per month.

Costumes: The best way to approximate costumes is to assume about \$50 per costume if under 10, closer to \$65 if over 10. If they are in a hip hop class, they will have one costume for this. If they are in a tap/ballet combo class, they could have 2 costumes for this. Please note...for younger children we try to find 2 in 1 costumes and discount costumes. The lowest last year was \$45 for both costumes (two in one) and the highest was \$95 for two separate costumes...the average was \$65 for both). As the kids get older, the costumes do get more expensive. Also, if your child is in lots of classes....your costume balance will be higher...if you have a 12 year old in tap/ballet, hip hop, contemporary, musical theater and lyrical...you are looking at 6-8 costumes. Please keep this cost in mind as you enroll for classes.

We will have NO RECITAL FEE THIS YEAR. Tickets for recital will run approximately \$10-15.

This year we are adding an unlimited option. This is per student or per number of students as indicated and they must be from the same immediate family. This is to help those families with kids who take a lot of classes and want to be able to take some of the technique classes as well. If they are unlimited and take up a spot in a class, attendance is expected and if they miss more than 3 times prior to November 15 drop date, they will be pulled from the class. Unlimited are still subject to same drop rules, costumes rules, etc. If you take a spot in class, we expect that you will be in that class. Also, unlimited is also only what they are qualified and approved to take...it does not mean you can show up and go to any class, any age, any level. Unlimited is \$200.00 per student per month. For competition kids, unlimited is \$250 per month and includes any/all comp routines (does not include entry fees, costumes, etc or special choreographer fees (not common)). If you have two rec students, unlimited is \$350. If you have two comp students, unlimited is \$400/month.

Also, if you recommend someone to the studio who enrolls and completes at least one month of class, you get 50% off one month of dance (up to \$40.00 max savings—if more than one parent is listed, the credit is split). They have to list your name on the enrollment form to get this credit so be sure to tell them to write you down! Some parents already have credits for this year from summer students!
